

Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings


Third Sunday of Easter

Two disciples who walked away to a distant village called Emmaus, perhaps, out of total disappointment over the events that had taken place about Jesus. They were confused and disturbed. Jesus had been killed, dashed their hopes of Israel's redemption. His tomb had been broken into and His body was missing. So now they were leaving Jerusalem, discussing and debating what it all meant. Today's gospel describes their mood like: they looked downcast. Jesus appeared and accompanied them on their journey. He listened to their story, and then they listened to his teachings. The breaking of the Word was an enriching encounter as it made their hearts filled with deep spiritual yearning. The breaking of bread opened their eyes of faith. Both experiences were so delightful that they transformed their despair into hope and happiness. They recognized the Risen Lord. They had known Jesus from a distance and now they had a close union with him. Each time we gather for Mass, we have the opportunity to encounter the Risen Lord in Word and Eucharist. May our eyes of our faith see Jesus manifest to us as we encounter him in the word and breaking of the bread, and in all the unexpected places he meets us.






THE EUCHARIST and BIG SCREEN PROJECTORS

We all know the Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life."¹ We also know Jesus himself taught just how important it is to celebrate his Eucharist.² The Liturgy of the Eucharist is that part of the Mass where we do what Jesus said to do and he becomes truly present – body, blood, soul, and divinity – under the appearances of bread and wine. This is what the Church means when she speaks of the "Real Presence" of Christ in the Eucharist.³


