



Palm Sunday

With this great liturgy of Palm Sunday, we are now entered upon Holy Week, in which we will be immersed into the greatest mysteries of our salvation. As Jesus enters Jerusalem today. He is aware of all the dynamics that surrounds Him, the destiny that awaits Him, the things that He will have to encounter in the following days. The gospels record the arrival of Jesus riding into the city on a donkey, while the crowds spread their cloaks and palm branches on the street and shout "Hosanna to the Son of David" and "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord" and they honor him as their long-awaited Messiah and King. The people who shouted Hosannas for him and called him a Messiah, soon would shout Crucify him and choose a criminal in place of the just man. As we "carry Jesus" to the world, we can expect to receive the same welcome that Jesus received on Palm Sunday, but we must also expect to meet the same opposition, crosses and trials later. If we need to be a real Christian we have to embrace the road to Calvary and be ready to accept certain opposition for the sake of God's Kingdom. As we carry the palm leaves to our homes, we are declaring our choice to accept Jesus as the King and ruler of our lives and our families. Palm Sunday is an occasion for us to prepare our hearts for the agony of His Passion and the joy of His Resurrection.



Holy Thursday Church Pilgrimage

There is an ancient Roman tradition to visit multiple churches after the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday night and to pray and "keep watch" before the Blessed Sacrament at the Altar of Repose in each of those churches. In the spirit of this tradition, everyone is invited to join the faithful of the Wheeling area for a Holy Thursday Pilgrimage this year on the evening of April 6. During the pilgrimage, the faithful will have the opportunity to visit five churches in Wheeling to pray before the Blessed Sacrament. A special booklet has been created which allows the pilgrims to follow along the narrative of Jesus' time in the Garden of Gethsemane as well as provide opportunities for personal prayer and meditation.


