

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The central theme of today's readings is that we should courageously live out our religious convictions and principles in our lives, as Jeremiah, Paul and Jesus did, even if doing so should result in our martyrdom and turn society upside down. Jesus makes an important statement in today's Gospel: "I have come to set the earth on fire.." Fire can do many different kinds of things. This is not the fire of destruction, the fire that ravages rain forests every year. It is the fire of heat and light. It is the fire that cleanses and purifies. It is the fire of God's presence as in the burning bush that Moses saw, as in the pillar of fire that accompanied the Israelites in the desert, as in the tongues of fire at Pentecost where the bringing of fire was mandated to the disciples, to the Church, to all of us. Once touched by the fire of Jesus our lives can never be the same. He ignites us to live fully; He pushes us into the center of life so that we are forced to take a stand for or against him. When truth needs to be spoken, when injustices are being perpetrated, it takes courage to be stand up sometimes alone and singlehanded. If we believe that God is truth and is always on the side of justice, especially for the weak and poor, then we cannot be God-believers unless we are truth- tellers.

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Children,

Welcome to Corpus Christi Church and our Parish Christian Faith Formation Program. At the baptism of a child, parents, and sponsors promise to teach their children the Catholic faith and "to bring them up according to the law of Christ and His Church." The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us, "The Sunday Celebration of the Lord's Day and His Eucharist is at the heart of the Church's life" (No. 2177). As a law of the Church, the Sunday Mass obligation binds Catholics.

Children that are at least 7 years old and have the use of reason. However, since first reception of the Sacraments of Penance and the Eucharist are at or about age 7 in the United States, it seems that children should be well accustomed to attending and participating in the Mass prior to that age. "Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child's earliest years. This happens when family members help one another grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and heart of liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents" (Catechism, 2226).

The Faith Formation program generally serves students in grades 1st-8th who attend public schools or non-Catholic private schools. It includes preparation for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We are delighted that you are here at Corpus Christi Church and we look forward to your time with us. We will resume full enrollment and in person classes. Our classes will be held at Corpus Christi School. These sessions will be on Sundays from 8:45am and until 10:00am. The Sunday Catechism program is followed by the Holy Mass at Corpus Christi Parish Church at 10:30am. The requirements for the reception of the Religious Education classes in either a Catholic Church Program or a Catholic School, and participation in parent and child meet-sessions, as well as retreats.

Registration is currently open. We require all registrations to be completed by August 15 so that we may begin to plan for classes that begin September 4, 2022. FOUNDATIONS FOR LITURGY

A five-week course is being offered through the University of Dayton's Virtual Learning Community for Faith Formation (VLCFF). This is a LIVE course which will be held at St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Wheeling on Tuesday evenings, from 6:00pm to 7:30pm, on the following dates: September 6, 13, 27 and October 4 and 11. The course is FOUNDATIONS FOR LITURGY. In this course, students will be able to explain the basic parts of the Mass including prayers, the three components of a church building, and the basic signs, symbols and rituals in liturgy that help us understand how God communicates with us. The course will cover "Signs, Symbols, and Rituals," "The Liturgical Year," "A Tour of the Church," "The Eucharist and Prayer Postures," and "The Liturgy of the Word and Eucharist." The course is being underwritten by the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston's Office of Evangelization & Catechesis, which pays 100% of the tuition.


