

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

As Jesus was walking along his way to Jerusalem someone asked him, "Lord is it true that few people will be saved?" The Gospel of today tells us that salvation is not automatic. Jesus stresses the need for constant fidelity and vigilance throughout our lives. Jesus reminds us that nobody can claim that he is "saved," possessing a "visa" to Heaven. The average Jew took heaven for granted because most Jewish people held the view that all Jews excluding the very worst would get into heaven. Just as the Jews became members of the covenant at Sinai by means of circumcision, so Christians become part of the covenant in Jesus through baptism. Mere faith in Jesus and membership in His Church by Baptism cannot guarantee salvation. It requires the cooperation and perseverance on our part to secure the kingdom of heaven. Today there are many doors "inviting us to enter, promising instant happiness, which is end in itself and has no future". But Jesus shines as a light in our lives that never goes out.

Beginning next week, Wednesday masses will be held at 11:00am with the Corpus Christi School staff and student body.



Dear Parents, Guardians, and Children,

Welcome to Corpus Christi Church and our Parish Christian Faith Formation Program. At the baptism of a child, parents, and sponsors promise to teach their children the Catholic faith and "to bring them up according to the law of Christ and His Church." The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us, "The Sunday Celebration of the Lord's Day and His Eucharist is at the heart of the Church's life" (No. 2177). As a law of the Church, the Sunday Mass obligation binds Catholics.


Children that are at least 7 years old and have the use of reason. However, since first reception of the Sacraments of Penance and the Eucharist are at or about age 7 in the United States, it seems that children should be well accustomed to attending and participating in the Mass prior to that age. "Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child's earliest years. This happens when family members help one another grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and heart of liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents" (Catechism, 2226).

The Faith Formation program generally serves students in grades 1st-8th who attend public schools or non-Catholic private schools. It includes preparation for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We are delighted that you are here at Corpus Christi Church and we look forward to your time with us. We will resume full enrollment and in person classes. Our classes will be held at Corpus Christi School. These sessions will be on Sundays from 8:45am and until 10:00am. The Sunday Catechism program is followed by the Holy Mass at Corpus Christi Parish Church at 10:30am. The requirements for the reception of the Religious Education classes in either a Catholic Church Program or a Catholic School, and participation in parent and child meet-sessions, as well as retreats.

Registration is currently open. We require all registrations to be completed by August 15 so that we may begin to plan for classes that begin September 18, 2022. FOUNDATIONS FOR LITURGY

A five-week course is being offered through the University of Dayton's Virtual Learning Community for Faith Formation (VLCFF). This is a LIVE course which will be held at St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Wheeling on Tuesday evenings, from 6:00pm to 7:30pm, on the following dates: September 6, 13, 27 and October 4 and 11. The course is FOUNDATIONS FOR LITURGY. In this course, students will be able to explain the basic parts of the Mass including prayers, the three components of a church building, and the basic signs, symbols and rituals in liturgy that help us understand how God communicates with us. The course will cover "Signs, Symbols, and Rituals," "The Liturgical Year," "A Tour of the Church," "The Eucharist and Prayer Postures," and "The Liturgy of the Word and Eucharist." The course is being underwritten by the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston's Office of Evangelization & Catechesis, which pays 100% of the tuition. The course instructor is Shirley Carter.
