Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

As human persons we often aim to possess all power and control, to be the first in every possible situation, to remain at the top and have a lead over the others. For at times our humility has been crushed by pride and we are not able to forge ahead. Often, we find ourselves comparing ourselves with others and usually we believe we are better than others. Consequently, we expect better treatment, more privileges and special places of honor for ourselves!

Today's Gospel warns us against all forms of pride and self-glorification. Jesus is at a meal in the house of one of the leading Pharisees. He notices the undignified scramble for the places of honor and is moved to comment on what he sees through a parable. It deals with an aspect of one's relationship with God. Our acceptance at the heavenly banquet will depend not on our merit or good deeds but on our acceptance of others now. Humility in a Christian sense is not a purely passive virtue; like faith, to which it is closely akin, it is highly active. "Pride makes us artificial, and humility makes us real." (Thomas Merton).

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Children,



Welcome to Corpus Christi Church and our Parish Christian Faith Formation Program. At the baptism of a child, parents, and sponsors promise to teach their children the Catholic faith and “to bring them up according to the law of Christ and His Church.” The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us, “The Sunday Celebration of the Lord’s Day and His Eucharist is at the heart of the Church’s life” (No. 2177). As a law of the Church, the Sunday Mass obligation binds Catholics.

Children that are at least 7 years old and have the use of reason. However, since first reception of the Sacraments of Penance and the Eucharist are at or about age 7 in the United States, it seems that children should be well accustomed to attending and participating in the Mass prior to that age. “Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child’s earliest years. This happens when family members help one another grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and heart of liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents” (Catechism, 2226).

The Faith Formation program generally serves students in grades 1st-8th who attend public schools or non-Catholic private schools. It includes preparation for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We are delighted that you are here at Corpus Christi Church and we look forward to your time with us. We will resume full enrollment and in person classes. Our classes will be held at Corpus Christi School. These sessions will be on Sundays from 8:45am and until 10:00am. The Sunday Catechism program is followed by the Holy Mass at Corpus Christi Parish Church at 10:30am. The requirements for the reception of the Religious Education classes in either a Catholic Church Program or a Catholic School, and participation in parent and child meet-sessions, as well as retreats.

Registration is currently open. Classes begin September 18, 2022. For details please contact the Parish Office. We will be in need of teachers to help with the catechism classes, if interested, please email Kate Ross at kross@ccwheeling.net.
