Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

19th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Placing all the three readings together the message that is given to us is to have deep faith in God and leave behind all things that can draw us away from him. The gospel reminds us how we should live our lives. We have to be ready and prepared at all times, like servants waiting for the master. He

will knock our door, and he wait if we open the door for him to come in. The house signifies our soul. If we shut our soul for him to come in, we are in danger spiritually. What is the purpose of human on earth? Saint Thomas Aquinas replied: our purposes are: to know Him, to love Him, to serve Him and to prepare our soul to be with Him in eternity. Going back to God created us body and soul, and the wise know how to take care both: body and soul. The Master will come and knock on our door at the unexpected hours. If anyone thinks like: "I will live a long time, I don't need to worry about death today." He/she is putting his/her souls at risk. As long as we are still on earth, we still have works to do, and we still have prayers to pray. Jesus' disciples should use their time on earth wisely. "Blessed are those servants whose master come and find him or her awake." How long will we live on earth is not important, but do we use the time God gives us on earth to do what God wants us to do?

As recent news reports have highlighted, areas of southern West Virginia and eastern Kentucky continue to be pummeled by severe weather resulting in extreme damage, loss of life, and destruction of entire communities.
