Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

Second Sunday of Advent

John the Baptist, in today's Gospel, challenges the Jews to prepare their lives for receiving their long-awaited Messiah. They have to prepare a highway in their hearts for their Messiah, by levelling the mountains of pride, and valleys of impurity and injustice, and by straightening their crooked ways. They are to get ready by repenting of their sins, renewing their lives, and expressing their repentance, by receiving the baptism of repentance in River Jordan. The word Repent means, to change our ways, to have a change of heart, that is, a radical transformation in our way of living. It means a conversion, a real turning around, a re-directing of one's whole life. Repentance for us is not a one-time action but must take place daily. John the Baptist tells us what has to be done during this Advent: the valleys of our shortcomings, and sins of omission, shall be filled in: the mountains of our pride and gance, shall be made low; the winding roads of our crooked ways, shall be straightened; and the rough ways of our bad behavior, shall be made smooth. Let us pray, "God, grant me the serenity, to accept the things, I cannot change; the courage, to change the things I can; and the wisdom, to know the difference."




