


# Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

### Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The point of today's gospel is for us to understand the root values Jesus is calling us; to have a heart that is forgiving, faithful and truthful. God who wills that human society be just and merciful; that human life be nourishes. and that all relationships be restored. God's law is not meant to restrain us, but to show us how to be fully human, living out of love. Jesus calls us to live in love, a love that complete us and make us whole, because it is God's love. What is the meaning of sin? According to Catechism of the Catholic Church, "it is an offense against or disobedience to God's commandments; preferring to do our will rather than the will of God." The best definition of sin is a rejection of the unconditional love of God to us. Sins can be summarized into three. First is sin of disobedience and rebellion. There are many things that we should but we don't like, because we are proud and stubborn. Second is sin of brother against brother. Just like Cain, he killed Abel because he was jealous. We don't usually kill our brother, but our hatred of brothers and sisters and friends is almost as deadly. Last is the sin of pride. It is like the story of Tower of Babel in the Old Testament. The people wanted to build a tower that would reach to heaven but God punished them. Their pride destroyed communication among them. How true is it in our lives? A disciple has to refrain from insulting the other or destroy his reputation.



The Ladies Guild is asking for baked goods from our parishioners for the Penny Auction on March 4th . Proceeds go to Corpus Christi Parish.


We're looking for cookies, fudge, brownies or a specialty item you may bake/make. We request that you place in baggies (2/bag) to sell.




