





The Super Bowl is believed to be the largest human trafficking event in the United States each year. (Statistics are available from 2019 onward. ") "Circuit girls" are trafficked from city to city to meet expected demand for their exploitation at large events like this. The Las Vegas location of this 2024 Super Bowl is especially concerning, due to Nevada's lax laws, and the common beliefs and practices - that Las Vegas provides an exemption from ethical behavior. These factors will likely cause an increase in crisis pregnancies among the victims, also.




