

## **Father Paul's Reflections**

on the Readings

## Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The gospel reading invites us to reflect on the significance of the light of Christ in our lives. Light dispels darkness. It gives us confidence because it points us in the right direction. It enables us to see things as they are. Whenever we experience powerfailures we are reminded that we are particularly dependent on light for clear vision and we realize how necessary light is in our everyday lives. Jesus used the image of light when speaking to his disciples. He told them that they were the light of the world, just as he was their light. The light of Christ is our guiding light. We feel secure in the light of Christ as it directs us through life. By imitating his teaching and example in their own lives they could, like light, offer guidance, direction, meaning and hope to other people. The disciples were to share and reflect the light of Christ, which would give light to the world. As Christians, we should make things visible, we should light up possibilities, and we should brighten our world. Our lives, what we do and the way we do things, should be a source of light and meaning for others.






