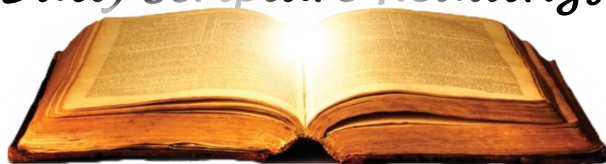
Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

It is said 'Every saint has a past; every sinner has a future.' In the faith life, in God's eyes there are no failures! With God's help we can rise to new heights in spite of failures. God needs us to carry on and never give up! Today's readings we meet three people, who are weak and fearful when God calls them. Each of them began by acknowledging his unworthiness and sinfulness, but ended up accepting God's invitation. Isaiah recognizes that he is not worthy, but he trusts in God and God purifies him for his mission. In the second reading Paul reminds us that he is the least of the apostles, but he is called by God for a special mission. In the gospel Simon Peter calls himself a sinful man, but Jesus made him the chief of the apostles. We can see three things about this Divine call: it comes from God, there is a purification and cleansing, and, finally, there is a willingness on the part of the one who is called to respond with assent. God can make use of the most unlikely people to fulfill divine purposes. God does not need our worthiness for He makes us worthy. He demands our faith and trust in his word. When all our efforts have failed, if we trust in his word and are ready to launch out again, he will make the impossible possible.

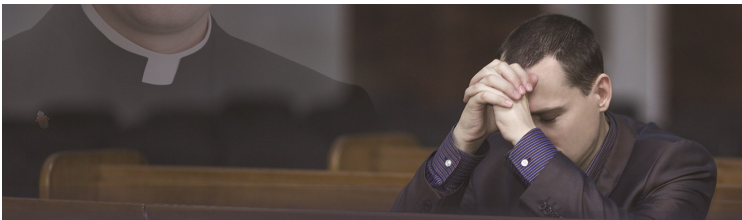

Original Sin

Why does the Catholic faith matter?

There are many different religions, and each at best only approximates the truth. But the Catholic faith is not merely one religion among many. It is utterly distinct from other religions because the faith of the Catholic Church is the true religion. This gives Catholics an enormous responsibility to understand what they believe and to communicate that truth to others. In this short essay and the five that follow, we will look at and deepen our understanding of some basic aspects of the Catholic faith. The first topic will be original sin.

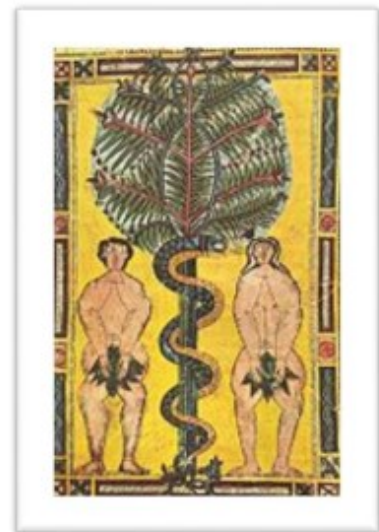
CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH 398

We must distinguish between two types of sin.

The first are evil acts chosen by us. For example, choosing to end an innocent human life is a sin. What we will focus on here, however, is the second but not least important kind of sin which is original sin. Each human (with the exception of Mary and Jesus) is conceived with guilt inherited from the first sin committed by our ancestors Adam and Eve. By choosing to disobey God and failing to trust Him by eating the fruit from the tree of knowledge, Adam and Eve “wanted to be like God, but without God” (Catechism of the Catholic Church 398). This is how sin entered the world, through disobedience and lack of trust in God.


Prior to the fall, man had “friendship with his Creator and...harmony with himself and the creation around him” (Catechism of the Catholic Church 374). Because of this first sin, Adam and Eve and their ancestors (the entire human race) lost this harmony and, most importantly, their friendship with God. Again, the harmony between man and God, man and creation, and man and himself was destroyed; some of the consequences of this are that we have to labor for our food, struggle against the temptation to do evil (the first kind of sin) and are subject to death and decay (Genesis 3: 16-19).

After Adam and Eve wrecked humankind’s relationship with the Creator, God, who is merciful, immediately began preparations to reconcile the human race with himself.


