

Father Paul's Reflections

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

"The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light." Saint Matthew saw Jesus as the Light. He came to bring a light of hope to people are living in distress. Are you living in darkness? How do I know I am living in the darkness? Prophet Isaiah talks about spiritual darkens. We may identify some kinds of darkness like: darkness of unbelieving, darkness of ignorance, darkness of stubbornness, darkness of hopeless, darkness of isolation or darkness of sins. Jesus calls us to repent, means he calls us to come out of our own darkness. He calls us to expose our mind and our heart to his light.

Let us repent as Jesus called us to do. We are called to follow Him. If we believe and do as God calls us to do, we will have more joy and peace in this life and in the life to come.
