## on the Readings

### Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Where do we really find happiness? Today's gospel on the beatitudes gives us an answer. The beatitudes are a way of living. They are the fullest measure of living the moral life. The virtues Jesus articulates are part and parcel of his life. To follow Jesus is to become a person of the beatitudes. The Beatitudes teach us, how to follow Christ in living as members of his eternal Kingdom. In today's world which is marked with cut throat competition and exploitation, the Beatitude could come up as a blueprint for a New Society with certain new characteristics. This new society will be all inclusive. The poor, and the marginalized, are favored more, as they have fallen outside the present society.

**Satan's Beatitude:** Blessed are those who are too tired, too busy, too distracted to spend an hour once a week with their fellow Christians in Church - they are my best workers. Blessed are those who wait to be asked and expect to be thanked - I can use them in my business. Blessed are those who are touchy. Soon they will stop going to Church - truly, they shall be my missionaries. Blessed are those who sow gossip and trouble - they are my beloved children. 

## **MAP Assessments give Students in WV Catholic Schools Clear Roadmap**

Backed by assessments that are given three times a year, the Catholic Schools of West Virginia provide educators, families, and the students the opportunity to identify any learning gaps, as well as identify areas where the student can be challenged at a higher level.

The diocesan schools partner with the Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) for their state-aligned, online Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) assessments.

“Our MAP assessments truly serve as a roadmap for us for grade level aptitude, and college and career readiness,” Associate Superintendent Jennifer Hornyak said.

“The NWEA tests are adaptive, meaning students are measured where they are across grade levels instead of just at their grade level,” she said and added, “The online test adjusts during the assessment based on the student’s right or wrong answers. A right answer challenges the student to a harder question. A wrong answer bumps down a level to identify where the student’s ability is in the subject area, resulting in an identification marker of what the child’s needs may be to grow in this subject area. The teacher then can adapt their lesson plan to help the student attain individual goals, grade level goals, and cross grade level goals.”

The MAP testing also identifies college and career readiness.

“That is another asset of the assessment model, providing us a clear look at what opportunities would be best for our students to help them be the best version of themselves after their educational career with us,” Hornyak said.





