Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The central theme of today's Scripture readings is that we gain eternal life through loving God living in our neighbors by becoming good neighbors. The scholar of the law asked Jesus, "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus answered with a counter question, "What is written in the law? The scholar replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and love your neighbor as yourself." The priest and Levite passed by on the other side deliberately putting a safe distance between themselves and the dying man. But the Samaritan felt compassion for him." Martin Luther King Jr. explained on the parable of the Good Samaritan with two questions. The first question that the priest and the Levite asked was, 'If I stop to help this man, what will happen to me?' " But then the Samaritan came by, and he reversed the question: 'if I do not stop to help this man, what will happen to him?' Today's gospel reminds us that we are the instruments of God and we ought to help those in need even though they are unlike us and even if we dislike them. Parish Religious Education Program

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Children,

Welcome to Corpus Christi Church and our Parish Christian Faith Formation Program. At the baptism of a child, parents, and sponsors promise to teach their children the Catholic faith and “to bring them up according to the law of Christ and His Church.” The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us, “The Sunday Celebration of the Lord’s Day and His Eucharist is at the heart of the Church’s life” (No. 2177). As a law of the Church, the Sunday Mass obligation binds Catholics. Children that are at least 7 years old and have the use of reason. However, since first reception of the Sacraments of Penance and the Eucharist are at or about age 7 in the United States, it seems that children should be well accustomed to attending and participating in the Mass prior to that age. “Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child’s earliest years. This happens when family members help one another grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and heart of liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents” (Catechism, 2226). The Faith Formation program generally serves students in grades 1st-8th who attend public schools or non-Catholic private schools. It includes preparation for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We are delighted that you are here at Corpus Christi Church and we look forward to your time with us. We will resume full enrollment and in person classes. Our classes will be held at Corpus Christi School. These sessions will be on Sundays from 8:45am and until 10:00am. The Sunday Catechism program is followed by the Holy Mass at Corpus Christi Parish Church at 10:30am. The requirements for the reception of the Religious Education classes in either a Catholic Church Program or a Catholic School, and participation in parent and child meet-sessions, as well as retreats.

Registration is currently open. We require all registrations to be completed by August 15 so that we may begin to plan for classes that begin September 4, 2022. 


