# Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

#### 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time


From time to time we receive guests into our homes and we would like to treat them well. First reading, Abraham received guests and he treated them to a good meal, well prepared. The guests felt happy and promised the gift of a son to Abraham and Sarah. Jesus was received into the home of Martha and Mary. Martha thought that the best way to treat Jesus was to serve him a sumptuous meal. But Mary chose to be with him and listen to him. You may be busy: you have got to work hard to come up in your business; you have got to get up early in the morning and go late to bed. Does life consist of working? You are working for your family, but do you spend time with your family? Do you look into their spiritual conditions? Jesus Say, 'you are busy about many things, but "one thing" is needed. Today Jesus invited us to break away from everything and sit at His feet. To sit at someone's feet is a posture of a disciple; it is a posture of learning. To sit at His feet is peace; to sit at His feet is strength; and to sit at His feet is life. That is the invitation to each of us: stop your business on Sabbath and be still and listen to Him.

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Children,

Welcome to Corpus Christi Church and our Parish Christian Faith Formation Program. At the baptism of a child, parents, and sponsors promise to teach their children the Catholic faith and "to bring them up according to the law of Christ and His Church." The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us, "The Sunday Celebration of the Lord's Day and His Eucharist is at the heart of the Church's life" (No. 2177). As a law of the Church, the Sunday Mass obligation binds Catholics.

Children that are at least 7 years old and have the use of reason. However, since first reception of the Sacraments of Penance and the Eucharist are at or about age 7 in the United States, it seems that children should be well accustomed to attending and participating in the Mass prior to that age. "Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child's earliest years. This happens when family members help one another grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and heart of liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents" (Catechism, 2226).

The Faith Formation program generally serves students in grades 1st-8th who attend public schools or non-Catholic private schools. It includes preparation for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We are delighted that you are here at Corpus Christi Church and we look forward to your time with us. We will resume full enrollment and in person classes. Our classes will be held at Corpus Christi School. These sessions will be on Sundays from 8:45am and until 10:00am. The Sunday Catechism program is followed by the Holy Mass at Corpus Christi Parish Church at 10:30am. The requirements for the reception of the Religious Education classes in either a Catholic Church Program or a Catholic School, and participation in parent and child meet-sessions, as well as retreats.

**Registration is currently open. We require all registrations to be completed by August 15 so that we may begin to plan for classes that begin September 4, 2022.** For details please contact the Parish Office. We will be in need of teachers to help with the catechism classes, if interested, please email Kate Ross at <u>kross@ccwheeling.net</u>.
