Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

There are several insights about prayer in the first reading where Abraham intercedes with God for Sodom and Gomorrah. Firstly, Abraham pleads not for himself but for the needs of others. Secondly, we see in Abraham a man who does not give up, he perseveres in his pleading with the Lord. It would appear at first glance that Abraham is bargaining with the Lord. But he is not asking something for himself nor is he offering to do something in return. Today's gospel, we see the person who wakes up a friend, in the middle of the night to ask for bread. He is asking for someone else's benefit. The point of the passage is not that prayer changes God but that it changes us so that we can accept whatever is God's will for us.

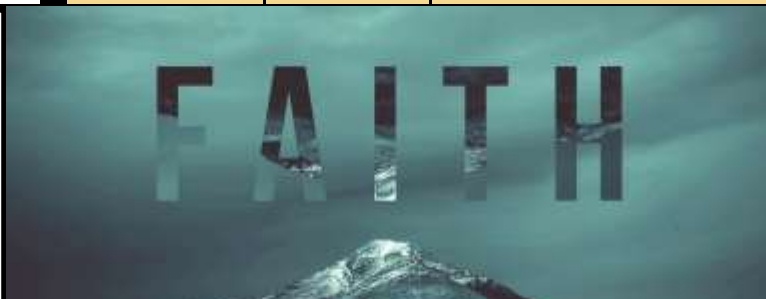

Parish Religious Education Program

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Children,

Welcome to Corpus Christi Church and our Parish Christian Faith Formation Program. At the baptism of a child, parents, and sponsors promise to teach their children the Catholic faith and “to bring them up according to the law of Christ and His Church.” The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us, “The Sunday Celebration of the Lord’s Day and His Eucharist is at the heart of the Church’s life” (No. 2177). As a law of the Church, the Sunday Mass obligation binds Catholics.

Children that are at least 7 years old and have the use of reason. However, since first reception of the Sacraments of Penance and the Eucharist are at or about age 7 in the United States, it seems that children should be well accustomed to attending and participating in the Mass prior to that age. “Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child’s earliest years. This happens when family members help one another grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and heart of liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents” (Catechism, 2226).

The Faith Formation program generally serves students in grades 1st-8th who attend public schools or non-Catholic private schools. It includes preparation for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We are delighted that you are here at Corpus Christi Church and we look forward to your time with us. We will resume full enrollment and in person classes. Our classes will be held at Corpus Christi School. These sessions will be on Sundays from 8:45am and until 10:00am. The Sunday Catechism program is followed by the Holy Mass at Corpus Christi Parish Church at 10:30am. The requirements for the reception of the Religious Education classes in either a Catholic Church Program or a Catholic School, and participation in parent and child meet-sessions, as well as retreats.

Registration is currently open. We require all registrations to be completed by August 15 so that we may begin to plan for classes that begin September 4, 2022. 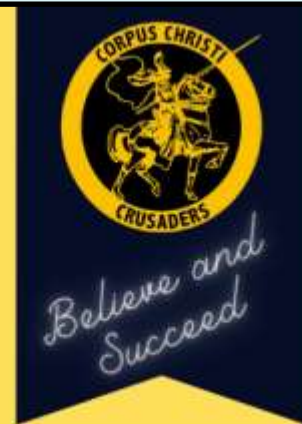
The School of Spiritual Direction program at Franciscan University of Steubenville will empower, equip, and accompany you to a depth of spirituality that you never dreamed possible.




