

Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Gospel, Jesus offers rest to those "who labor and are burdened", if they will accept His "easy yoke and light burden." By declaring that his "yoke is light," Jesus affirm that whatever God sends us is made to fit our needs and our abilities exactly. Some of us have some pretty heavy burdens to carry in life. Perhaps it is a physical hardship that makes life difficult. May be someone in your family has a serious illness and you are worried about them

I don't know what the burdens are that you have in your life, but I do know that there are some that you just can't handle by yourself. Jesus said, come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens and I will give you rest. Does that mean that if we will ask him, God will take all of our troubles away? Jesus does not promise a life without burdens. On the other hand, he offers a way of overcoming them. When the load is too heavy, he will help us to carry it, and there is no burden that is too heavy for Jesus. If we are able to spare time to be with the Lord and able to download our worries, concerns and anxieties in the presence of the Lord, it would mean that we are simple and humble people and the Lord is pleased to give us inner peace and joy. He is always near; and he gives us the help we need, that we may never faint beneath




