The Feast of Corpus Christi

Today's feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus constantly calls us beyond ourselves to sacrificial love for others. Today's Gospel significantly does not speak of the Eucharistic meal but rather of another meal that Jesus shared with the multitude. The setting for this meal is the large crowd of people, who have followed Jesus into this deserted and lonely place. The disciples see the presence of crowd and the deserted place as problems, and so they ask Jesus to send the crowd away. Their solution was to get rid of the problem! Jesus is not thinking of the problem but his concern for the people. In the face of problems, we encounter, we often think there is so little we can do. Jesus takes the five loaves and the two fish, the tiny contribution of the disciples and uses it to share it with the multitude. When we willingly offer the little that we have to be shared with others, God gives the increase; the little becomes much in God's hands. We are invited to be actively involved not passive at the Eucharist, we are called to nourish others, like He did.






