

The Most Holy Trinity

Today we celebrate the solemnity of the Holy Trinity, the feast of the Triune God manifested in three persons, the Father, Son and the Spirit. The mystery of the Holy Trinity is one of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity, and the greatest mystery of our faith, namely, that there are three divine persons, sharing the same divine nature in one God. We have Father who is the creator, Son the redeemer and Holy Spirit the sanctifier and the counselor. The divine unity is Triune. The unifying factor among the Holv Trinity is love. The three Persons in the Trinity, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, represent the fullness of love. The Father loves the Son: the Son loves the Father. The Holy Spirit is their love for each other. The Holy Spirit is the real model of our Family life. We should always be creative like the Father, compassionate like His son and share our talents in the service of others like the Holy spirit. May the Holy Trinity bless us and our families.


USE OF PROJECTOR DURING MASS


