



Father Paul's Reflections

on the Readings



Fourth Sunday of Lent

Today we are invited to meditate, to think deeply, about sight, blindness, light and darkness. Today's gospel narrates the story of Jesus healing the blind man. The healing of the man born blind gives us 3 insights into the sources of spiritual light;

a). The light of the Word: Jesus asks the blind man to go and wash himself in the pool of Siloam. It is the light of Jesus' word that guides him to the pool. In order to receive light from God, one needs to follow His commandments.

b). The light of experience: The man seems ignorant of Jesus' identity but he has a personal experience of Him. It is this experience that helps him face all sorts of persecution.

c). The light of Faith: When Jesus reveals himself to the man, he worships Him and accepts Him as his Lord. The Jews lack this light of faith. Hence they reject Jesus and prefer to remain in darkness.

In which area of life do I need to start a journey from darkness to light?






