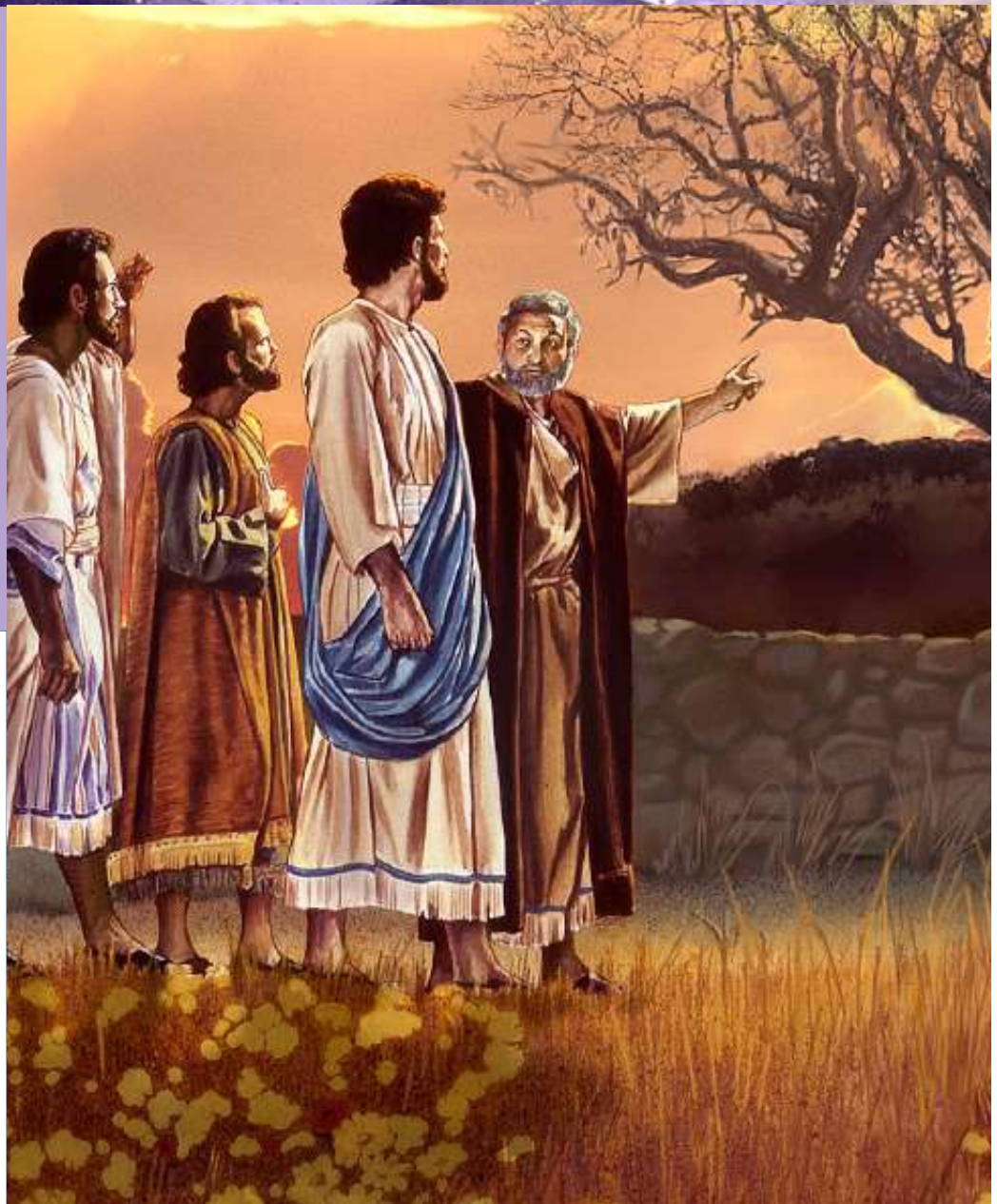

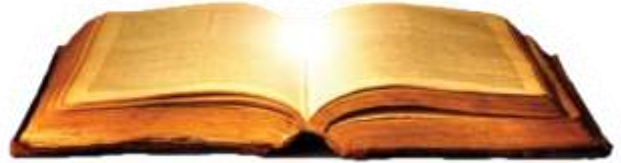

Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

Third Sunday in Lent

During this time of Lent there is an invitation to examine our lives and change for the better through a process of repentance and the need for the transformation of heart. Throughout history God calls His people to repentance, renewal to return to him. Today's gospel mentions a parable of Jesus namely the unproductive fig tree which stresses God's divine patience and tolerance. In the Gospel of today, Jesus speaks of the tree which is alive but it does not fulfill its duty of bearing fruit. There is a demand that it should be cut down. The man responsible for the tree requests the owner to give it one more opportunity to fulfill its purpose. The fig tree reminds us of two kinds of human persons, those who give and those who take. Those who give symbolize the sacrifice they make and fulfill the purpose of their existence. They give what they have without holding back anything for themselves and this is in generosity. If we are faithful to our relationship with God, we are liberated and bear much fruit. God is giving us another chance this lent!

The Season of Lent

The season of Lent is a period of preparation. Just like during the season of Advent we prepare for Christmas, in Lent, we are preparing for Easter. Easter is a celebration of Christ's death and resurrection. Christ died and atoned for our sins, we should rejoice and be happy! However, while Easter is a joyful time, Lent is somber and serious. We are serious during Lent not merely because we are trying to prepare the Church externally for the season of Easter (i.e. changing the decorations and music); far more importantly, we are trying to ready ourselves for the season of Easter.



"Restore us to thyself, O LORD, that we may be restored!"

(Lamentations 5: 21)

It would not be appropriate to visit a neighbor's house for dinner grimy and dirty, you would have to wash first. During Lent we do penance to change ourselves interiorly, "cleaning" our hearts for the celebration of Easter. The sacrifices that we make during Lent are a means to foster holiness in ourselves. To repent from sin and turn back to God. In his letter to the Romans, St. Paul says that "true circumcision is not outward, in the flesh. Rather,... circumcision is of the heart, in the spirit, not the letter." For the Jews, circumcision is a sign of God's covenant with Israel ([Genesis 17: 12-14](#)). Here, St. Paul is saying that external, bodily circumcision does not make one holy. Rather, Christians must circumcise their hearts, or in other words, become better persons ([Romans 2: 28-29](#)).

We can see the need for conversion and repentance embodied in **Lenten acts of penance** such as **prayer, fasting, and almsgiving** (not only money but, also giving one's time and talents to others). It is important to remember that, for example, merely abstaining from meat on Friday does not itself make one a better person. Rather, the suffering that the exterior act brings about is a tool that we can use to change ourselves interiorly. The suffering brought about through acts of penance can be "offered up" to God as a sacrifice or be used to enter deeper into prayer, recalling Christ's suffering on the cross.



In conclusion, let us reflect on these words from the Catechism:

- ❖ "[t]he human heart is heavy and hardened. God must give man a new heart ([Ezekiel 36: 26-27](#)).
- ❖ Conversion is, first of all, a work of the grace of God who makes our hearts return to him: "Restore us to thyself, O LORD, that we may be restored!" ([Lamentations 5: 21](#)).
- ❖ God gives us the strength to begin anew. It is in discovering the greatness of God's love that our heart is shaken by the horror and weight of sin and begins to fear offending God by sin and being separated from him. The human heart is converted by looking upon him whom our sins have pierced." ([CCC 1432](#)).
