



Fifth Sunday of Lent

Today's gospel unfolds four stages in the journey from death to life. a) Stage of consolation: Jesus consoles Lazarus' sisters with His presence and shed tears at the tomb. The crowd witnesses His compassion for them and Lazarus. b) Stage of assurance: The sisters express their faith in Jesus' power. Jesus assures them that He will rise again. This assurance springs from Jesus' selfrevelation; "I am the resurrection and the Life". c) Stage of liberation: Jesus' command to roll away the stone causes restlessness in the crowd but He proceeds to call Lazarus out. Lazarus is liberated from darkness, death and bondage. d) Stage of new life: Jesus tells the people to unbind Lazarus' hands and feet and let him go, a command to allow him to begin a new life of freedom, light and life. We are called to embrace the reality of our own mortality, but also to hold fast to the hope of new life and transformation through Christ. In doing so, we can find comfort and strength in the knowledge that, no matter what we may face in this life, we are never alone and that Christ is with us always.




