



# THE EUCHARIST and BIG SCREEN PROJECTORS



A 21st Century Issue for the Church

We all know the Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." We also know Jesus himself taught just how important it is to celebrate his Eucharist. The Liturgy of the Eucharist is that part of the Mass where we do what Jesus said to do and he becomes truly present — body, blood, soul, and divinity — under the appearances of bread and wine. This is what the Church means when she speaks of the "Real Presence" of Christ in the Eucharist.<sup>3</sup>

Knowing just how important the Eucharistic Celebration is the question facing many Catholic Churches is whether big projector images, changing

screens and flashing pretty pictures on the wall are respectful to Jesus. Are these distractions consistent with the humble focus we should have on God, his sacrifice and his mercy at this most important moment.

To show respect for Jesus and his Eucharist and to minimize the distractions for the faithful who want to pray the Eucharist we, at Corpus Christi, will pause big screen projection during this most important portion of the Mass. For these

few minutes of the Mass let our focus be on Jesus not TV.
