



Pentecost Sunday


Today, we are celebrating Pentecost Sunday, the day when the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples and the church was founded. For the apostles, this event meant they were no longer the same fear stricken, ignorant men. Fear had given way to courage. Until then, they had stayed behind closed doors. Now they stepped out, with undving faith in the indwelling spirit, and were constantly amazed at His power, working in and through them. Where the Spirit comes, radical upheavals and transformation always happen: barriers fall, doors are opened wide; all the towers built by human hands and designed by "the wisdom of this world" shake; fear and passivity disappear; initiatives are developed, and courageous decisions are made. Without the Holy Spirit, we would be a disorganized crowd. With the Holy Spirit, we are the Body of Christ. It is our duty to transform our parish into a church united, loving, forgiving and sharing communities. Let us be an agent of Holy Spirit, in action and passion-by forgiving the offenses, raising up the poor, burning up the egoistic tendencies and pride, being zealous in proclaiming the Word of God, standing for truth, and longing for perfection. 



Two five-week courses are being offered through the University of Dayton's Virtual Learning Community for Faith Formation (VLCFF). These courses are hybrid models. They are composed of both weekly live two-hour zoom lectures as well as a rich variety of online course materials and discussion experiences through the University of Dayton's Virtual Learning Community For Faith Formation (VLCFF). The Mass

In this course we will examine the core principles of the Eucharistic liturgy as found in the foundational documents of the Mass. We will consider its history and make connections between the modern liturgy and the historical context. Our central point of discussion throughout the course will be focused on the celebration of the Paschal Mystery. Over the course of the five weeks, we will take a deep dive into the elements of the Sunday celebration and its component parts. This course will be of value for liturgical ministers, RCIA Team members, and anyone interested in learning more about this most central celebration of all the baptized. All course materials are online, and we will meet for class lecture/discussion once a week on Tuesday evenings 7-9 pm beginning May 23rd

Images of Jesus

Through this course the participant will have the opportunity to examine, from a variety of theological perspectives, what we know and believe about the central figure of the Christian faith and arguably the most influential person who ever walked the earth. After looking at many different resources, the student will be able to form a personal answer to "Who do you say that I am?"

We will look at the images of Jesus in the New Testament, as understood in theology today, as understood in the Paschal Mystery and as encountered in the liturgical life of the Church. All course materials are online and we will meet for class lecture/discussion once a week on Wednesday evenings 7-9 pm beginning May 24th. This course is part of the sequence for the catechetical certification.
