

33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel Jesus assures the Apostles that he will be with them no matter what hardships they face. He teaches them that authentic Christian living is about meeting the challenges of the day and not just thinking about when the end will come. The Gospel presents us the scene where Jesus and his disciples were looking at Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives at the object of his mission. Jesus uses this episode to teach about the end of the world to come and about the persecutions the disciples will have to endure. The Gospel tells us that we are to get ready for that day when God will call us to himself. Our faith tells us that there is no need to live in fear and anxiety regarding the future.

Everything ends. But the words of Jesus will not pass away. Yet people just do not take it seriously. We believe the words of movie and TV personalities so easily. That is why we immediately buy the products they endorse in those TV commercials. We believe the words of the politicians who give us false promises and blatant lies. We believe the rumors spread by our neighbors and friends. But many do not take seriously and would even willfully ignore the words of Jesus. He is a God who never leaves us, both, when life leads us to dark times as well as to bright times. The Lord who faithfully walks with us and sustains us with his understanding in our moments of failures, forgiveness in moments of sin, encouragement in moments of challenges, appreciation in moments of successes. Keep awake, and keep walking, the Lord is with us.
