


Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

The first reading from the Book of Daniel, speaks of the end of the world. The prophets were reassuring the people who were losing hope that they should not give up. In the Gospel of Mark, we see Jesus describes the end of time. "The sun will be darkened, and the moon will lose its light, and the stars will fall from the heaven." There will always be difficult moments in our lives. These are not a punishment from God; they are the entry point for His coming into our lives.

Jesus asked his disciples, to be vigilant in the face of tribulation and persecution. Salvation is promised to those who endure till the end. As we struggle to live in troubled times, as we are battered by the storms of life, only our faith vision will help us to look beyond to the Lord who will never abandon us. The greatest spiritual lesson to be learnt in life is that the Lord is the only one who will be constant in our life; he is the only reliable one. Everyone and everything else will fail us. 
