Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Colorful falling leaves and the earthward drifting of the season's first snow, both directing our attention to remember the dead. The faith in the resurrection reflected in the life of the seven brothers in the first reading of today. They preferred to die rather than break the law of God. They refused to eat pork meat because it was not allowed by the law of their God. They were convinced that it is better to die than to disobey God, because their death will not be the end. The words and conviction of these brothers show that their faith was their life. They have something to teach us today. In our world, we readily say "no" to God in order to follow the demands of the world. The resurrection of Jesus is the basis of our faith. St Paul says that if Christ had not risen, our faith would have been in vain. It is His resurrection that assures us of our own resurrection. While we make the world a comfortable place to live, let us also prepare for a more comfortable existence after the present life by the way we live. Today Jesus reminds us that the goal of our life is eternal happiness in the Kingdom of Heaven.
