

Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

32nd Sunday in Ordinary 7ime

The two widows – in the Gospel and in the first reading- are inspiring. The widow of Zarephath gave to Elijah her last meal, and was ready to die afterwards. God did not let her jar of flour, and jug of oil, go empty. The poor widow in the Gospel, gave clear witness by contributing all she had - her whole livelihood to God. The two small coins were all she had to survive, but she still gave them all, equal to giving her whole life. People like these two women may be simple, but they have large and generous hearts and know how to love, holding nothing back. The world is enough for man's need, but the world is not enough for man's greed. What really matters is that people take care of each other. Nobody is so poor, as to have nothing to give; nobody is so rich, as to have nothing to receive. God looks not at the greatness of the work, but at the love with which it is performed.' God loves a cheerful giver!
