### Ecclesiology: The Beginnings of the Church

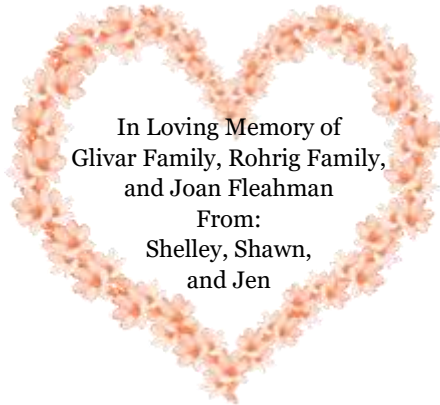


