

# Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The main theme of all reading today is faith. The Gospel gives a contrast between the judge and the widow. Who is more powerful? The judge is in position of power. His power was based solely on his human power. The widow, on the other hand, had nothing, except her faith in God. She persisted in her prayer, and never got tired of imploring the judge for justice. Human power is no match to divine power. That is why, it is said, "The most powerful man on earth is one who kneels down and prays." Today Jesus reminds us that we should never give up our faith even when God seems silent at the moment. Saint Monica is a model for all of us about praying patiently and not loose heart. In many years, her tears are her prayers. She offered all her sacrifices and prayers for the conversion of her husband and son St. Augustine. Finally, both were converted and her son became a great saint of the Church. With God nothing impossible! We plan our future by seeing the present. But God plans the present by knowing our future. 




