



30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel parable about the Pharisee and the tax collector, Jesus reminds us that God hears the prayers those who approach Him in humility with a repentant heart. God did not hear the prayer of the Pharisee because he exalted himself. The problem isn't in his actions, but rather his attitude. Reading over the parable, what is most disturbing is his claim: "God, I thank you that I am not like other people." Perhaps the Pharisee's greatest sin is his denial of fundamental human solidarity. The tax collector is a sinner, but at least he knows it. He is in touch with his need for God. His prayer comes from a heart open to being challenged and transformed by God's love and forgiveness. He wears no masks; aware of his unworthiness, he has no choice but to trust in God's mercy. The tax collector's prayer, "O God, be merciful to me, a sinner," was heard because he humbled himself, acknowledging his sins and requesting God's mercy. So what is the real difference between the Pharisee and the tax collector? It is not that one is righteous and that the other is a sinner. Both, in fact, are sinners. The difference lies at the level of their ability to accept who they are before God. How do I see myself before God? Do I stand in solidarity with all my brothers and sisters, whose fate is somehow linked with my own?


