Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The relationship between God and man is a special bond of love. Love involves the risk of taking and giving. In the first reading, we have the presentation of the love of God in the form of the Ten Commandments. The chosen people were invited to love God with their whole hearts. In the Gospel, we have the summary of the Law given by Jesus to love God with the whole heart, mind, and strength and to love one's neighbor as the person would love himself or herself. The neighbor is not the person, who lives next door, but any human being, who happens into our life. This neighbor is, especially the person, that we don't want to help, the person who may have injured us, the person who seems unworthy of our help. In other words, we are to love God, living in others. To love means to go beyond ourselves, to rise above our own need, to stretch out to someone, to see the faces of, those who desperately need our love, and indeed, to give ourselves to others. Love involves total giving, and sacrificing oneself. As we offer this Eucharist today and receive the Lord in our heart, let us ask the grace that we may extend our love to all and that we may discover the presence of Jesus in our brothers and sisters.
