

# Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

### 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Scripture readings are about the bond of love that marriage creates between a man and a woman, a bond that God intends to be permanent. The Gospel teaches that family life is sacred, that husband and wife are partners with equal rights and that the destruction of the family by divorce will result in the destruction of society.

Marriage is a partnership. Good partnerships emerge out of mutual understanding and mutual respect. Marriage is a union based on committed sharing, and forgiving, sacrificial agapelove. True love is neither physical, nor romantic. True love is an acceptance of, all that is, has been, will be, and will not be. Sometimes, it is good for us to act blind and ignore one another's short comings in order to be happy. No matter how many times the teeth bite the tongue they still stay together in one mouth. That is the spirit of forgiveness. Forgiveness is the medicine of family joy and happiness. Family must be a place of life and not a place of death; a place of forgiveness, a place of paradise and not a place of hell. A family is a place of support and not of gossip and slander of one another. It must be a place of welcome not a place of rejection.




