

# Father Paul's Reflections on the Readings

# 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings of today present the theme of gratitude that should come spontaneously from the heart of every individual. Today's first reading we have the healing of Naaman the Syrian and the expression of his gratitude to God for taking away his sickness through his prophet Elisha. Naaman was ready to reward the prophet generously; but Elisha refused to accept any reward for the divine

blessing. Because he was just happened to be a channel for the divine blessing. A foreigner becomes a model of faith to God's chosen people. In the Gospel we have the story of the ten lepers who come to Jesus for healing. Only one of them, a Samaritan healed of leprosy returns to Jesus to praise God and express his gratitude to for such a grace while the nine others who were healed show no gratitude at all. We all are aware that we have been the recipients of gifts from God. When gratitude is replaced by an attitude of entitlement, everybody suffers. If we replace our attitude of entitlement with an attitude of gratitude, our world will turn out to be heavenly. Dear Friends, count your blessings instead of your crosses; Count your joys instead of your grief; count your friends instead of your enemies; Count your smile instead of your tears; Count on God instead of yourself.

# LETTER ON RESPECT FOR THE LIVES OF MOTHERS AND CHILDREN

As Catholics throughout the world prepare to celebrate "Respect Life" month beginning October 1, Bishop Mark Brennan has released a letter on respect for the lives of mothers and children. The letter is also in response to the recent law signed by Governor Justice which regulates the practice of abortion in West Virginia.

"My brothers and sisters, our Church is both pro-child and pro-woman. As the prolife movement long ago realized, seeking only to limit or eliminate abortions is not enough. We must also provide support to mothers before and after they give birth and to their families," Bishop Brennan says in the letter.




