



24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Two parables of today's gospel - on lost sheep and lost coin- declare the magnitude of the mercy of God. They were lost but there was great rejoicing when they are found. These parables explain firstly, God's infinite mercy and His desire to seek, find and save the lost. It is not we who find God; it is God who finds us. He waits patiently for our return to His loving arms. Secondly, God values of the individual person. Jesus deliberately mentioned, only one specific sheep and one particular coin. This is to emphasize that in the eyes of God each one is valuable. In this world nowadays, societies are run by the principle of "majority rules". Even if the person is absolutely correct he is considered of no value and his principle is not respected if he does not have the majority. Sadly, the value of the human person is reduced to mere numbers. These parables remind us that God loves each one of us, not as a member of a big group but as a unique individual person created in the image and likeness of God. Every human person is precious in the eyes of God. These parables also remind us that we have a God who welcomes sinners and forgives their sins whenever return to Him with they genuine repentance.






