

25th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's parable may confuse most of us. We may ask: why did Jesus praise the dishonest steward that he acted prudently? Because he was astute to realize a basic truth about his future when he might not have access to the kind of wealth which he could squander around. He said to himself, "Now that my master is taking the stewardship from me, what am I to do? Here then is the crux of the story of today: the steward could have very well asked the debtors to give him part of the debt. After all, the master seems to have no idea of the amount owed to him by his debtors. He plans to do something more lasting: to use of the wealth to build something more lasting - friendships. He uses the present wealth to invest on future relationships. The people of this age diligently works to make their lives secure, comfortable and influential here on earth, compromising the kingdom values. We are all stewards of what God has entrusted to us; so, some day we will have to give Him an account of our stewardship. Let us be shrewd in seeking God's kingdom and its values.








A VIRTUAL PILGRIMAGE SERIES WITH SR. SALLIE LATKOVICH, CSJ


