# Father Paul's Reflections

## on the Readings

### 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus gave the two parables about prudence and foresight. A man planning to build a tower must calculate carefully if he has enough money and resources to finish the project. The king marching forward to wage battle with another king must also make sure he has enough men to win the battle.

In both cases, careful study, planning and preparation are essentially needed. Being a Christian involves two basic movements: come and go. At all times, Jesus invites us: "Come to me! Follow me!" And after following him, he will send us on a mission: "Go, and proclaim the Good News!" In both movements, our reply should be "yes" so that God's plan will be realized. In the first place, to say "yes" to Jesus means deliberately putting him as the center and the top priority of our life. Secondly, following Jesus requires that we bear our cross patiently. The cross is the key that opens the narrow door to God's kingdom. Nowadays, many people reject the cross. They abhor sacrifice and sufferings, and would rather run after money, comfort and luxury. As the saying goes, "when money talks, the truth is silent." Our "yes" to Jesus ultimately means we are willing to pay the price of following him – even at the cost of our own life. A song by the Charismatic Renewal Movement beautifully expresses this: "I have decided to follow Jesus; no turning back, no turning back. The cross before me, the world behind me; no turning back, no turning back."

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Children,



Welcome to Corpus Christi Church and our Parish Christian Faith Formation Program. At the baptism of a child, parents, and sponsors promise to teach their children the Catholic faith and “to bring them up according to the law of Christ and His Church.” The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us, “The Sunday Celebration of the Lord’s Day and His Eucharist is at the heart of the Church’s life” (No. 2177). As a law of the Church, the Sunday Mass obligation binds Catholics.

Children that are at least 7 years old and have the use of reason. However, since first reception of the Sacraments of Penance and the Eucharist are at or about age 7 in the United States, it seems that children should be well accustomed to attending and participating in the Mass prior to that age. “Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child’s earliest years. This happens when family members help one another grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and heart of liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents” (Catechism, 2226).

The Faith Formation program generally serves students in grades 1st-8th who attend public schools or non-Catholic private schools. It includes preparation for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We are delighted that you are here at Corpus Christi Church and we look forward to your time with us. We will resume full enrollment and in person classes. Our classes will be held at Corpus Christi School. These sessions will be on Sundays from 8:45am and until 10:00am. The Sunday Catechism program is followed by the Holy Mass at Corpus Christi Parish Church at 10:30am. The requirements for the reception of the Religious Education classes in either a Catholic Church Program or a Catholic School, and participation in parent and child meet-sessions, as well as retreats.

**Registration is currently open. Classes begin September 18, 2022.** For details please contact the Parish Office. We will be in need of teachers to help with the catechism classes, if interested, please email Kate Ross at [kross@ccwheeling.net](mailto:kross@ccwheeling.net).

Father gave all the students a goodie bag filled with candy and a personal flashlight for their backpacks.







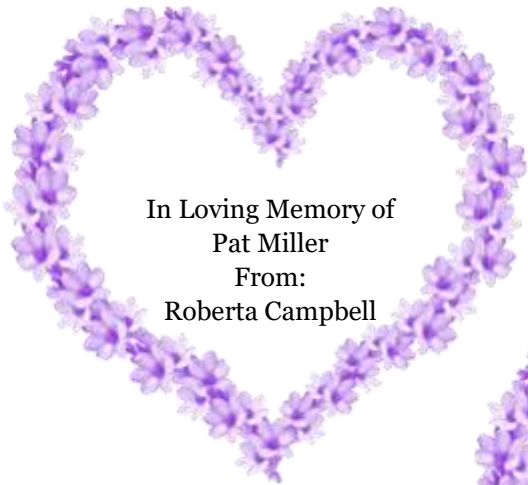

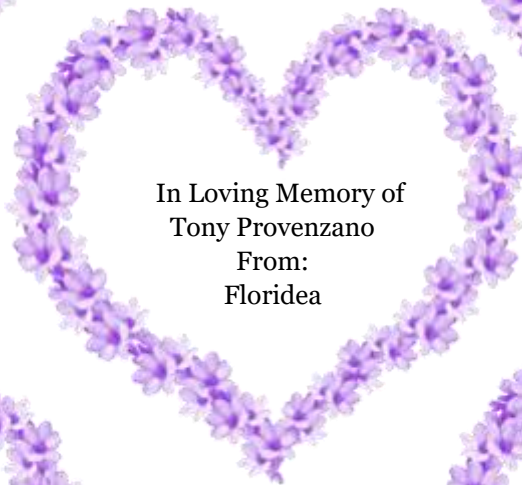
