

To the man who asks Jesus to urge his brother to divide the property with him. Probably greed lies behind the man's request. But Jesus has not to come to settle legal questions that are put to religious teachers of that time. Jesus rejects the role of judge in family disputes inheritance. about That covetousness and love for luxurious living are the man's concerns is clear from the parable of the rich fool that Jesus tells on this occasion. The rich man in the parable foolishly thinks the crop he harvests will give him happiness and so he wants to store it for himself. It turns out he will not be able to do so, because life is a gift from God, who can take it any time. The man would have been wise if he has instead decided to share his riches with the less privileged, poor and hungry. Christian existence is about accumulating spiritual wealth, not material wealth.



Dear Parents, Guardians, and Children,

Welcome to Corpus Christi Church and our Parish Christian Faith Formation Program. At the baptism of a child, parents, and sponsors promise to teach their children the Catholic faith and "to bring them up according to the law of Christ and His Church." The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us, "The Sunday Celebration of the Lord's Day and His Eucharist is at the heart of the Church's life" (No. 2177). As a law of the Church, the Sunday Mass obligation binds Catholics.

Children that are at least 7 years old and have the use of reason. However, since first reception of the Sacraments of Penance and the Eucharist are at or about age 7 in the United States, it seems that children should be well accustomed to attending and participating in the Mass prior to that age. "Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child's earliest years. This happens when family members help one another grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and heart of liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents" (Catechism, 2226).

The Faith Formation program generally serves students in grades 1st-8th who attend public schools or non-Catholic private schools. It includes preparation for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We are delighted that you are here at Corpus Christi Church and we look forward to your time with us. We will resume full enrollment and in person classes. Our classes will be held at Corpus Christi School. These sessions will be on Sundays from 8:45am and until 10:00am. The Sunday Catechism program is followed by the Holy Mass at Corpus Christi Parish Church at 10:30am. The requirements for the reception of the Religious Education classes in either a Catholic Church Program or a Catholic School, and participation in parent and child meet-sessions, as well as retreats.

Registration is currently open. We require all registrations to be completed by August 15 so that we may begin to plan for classes that begin September 4, 2022. 


